### 6. April Senate Meeting Report (Jessica)

Jessica Esseltine sent a report about April Senate Meeting:

This month was nominations and elections for senate-appointed committees. Caroline and Nicole have been nominated for the University Research Board (URB) and as there are two postdoc seats and only two nominees, both Caroline and Nicole have been acclaimed for the 2018-2019 URB. Nicole was also nominated for a second term with the Senate Subcommittee on University Planning (SCUP) and again with no competition has been acclaimed. The official observer senate seat for PAW is traditionally filled by the next PAW president.

It was also budget day for senate. Within the nearly \$1B (!) operating and capital budgets, Western has allocated \$226K for a one-year pilot program to fund internal postdoctoral fellowships. This should fund ~4-5 one-year fellowships across campus which is not much, but it is a start. After years of pushing, senate is finally moving ahead with the pilot program, lets hope it gets expanded and made a permanent part of future budgets!
