- 4. Update on Postdoc dues overcharging, and mobilizing for a new/stronger parent union for TAs and Postdocs at UWO (PSAC Local) Shannon Potter, Matthew S. Fox and Bode Oyeneye presented about this topic. The information presented by them is shown in items 4.1 and 4.2:

4.1- Update on Postdoc dues overcharging : Union uses 1.6% gross salary and the UWO has been charging this on the gross salaries of postdocs. The average postdoc salary is around \$45,000 so as an example with the number of postdocs at UWO with this average salary, this leads to \$44,000 / year in overcharges. UWO should be calculating dues based on the minimum negotiated salary described in our collective agreement. Currently the minimum is \$34,000 so we should be paying no more than ~\$45.34. PSAC610 encourages the postdocs to check any discrepancy in their pay stubs. They sent an email about these issues a few months ago. PSAC National should pay this overcharge for all postdocs. Possibly, PSAC will pay it next September.
