The horrific loss of four members of our London Muslim community on Sunday night has shocked us all. Our thoughts as an association are with Afzaal family as well as our Muslim community who now face another reminder of the islamophobia that pervades our society. We stand in solidarity with our Muslim colleagues in the postdoc community and stand against the hatred that led to this tragedy.

1. Land Acknowledgment

We acknowledge the tragedy over the discovery of bodies found in British Columbia last week. It remembers us of the injustice caused to indigeneous people over Canada in the past. We acknowledge the Anishinaabek, Haudenosaunee, Lunaapeewak and Attawandaron peoples, whose traditional lands we are gathered upon today.
